Category 3 - RISING SATELLITE

A) Academic

Have made overall, significant, marked progress during the course of the Academic Year.

B) Character

• Have NO 2.0 or below (Needs Improvement or Unsatisfactory) for the 2nd semester in Social Development and Work Habits. (The number of students to be awarded per class is at the discretion of the classroom teacher.)

Criteria for Ineligibility
